


New Sight Word Game

Dear Parents,

This week we learned a new sight word game called CRACK! Do you have left over plastic Easter eggs? You can use them to play this game! Just cut apart the sight word cards and place them in the eggs. Put the eggs in a container or basket and you are all set! Directions are listed on the next page. We also included two lists of sight words. The first group of words is from the 3rd nine weeks and the second group of words is from the 4th nine weeks. You can use the words however you see fit.

Directions: Cut apart the word cards and put one in each plastic Easter egg. Then put the plastic eggs in some sort of basket. Take turns pulling out an egg, opening it, and reading the sight word out loud. If the player says the word correctly, they keep the egg/card. If the player doesn't know the word, they put the egg back in the basket. If a player gets a CRACK card in their egg, they must return all their eggs to the basket. The player with the most eggs at the end of the game is the winner!


