

# Sight Words

Dear Parents,

On the list attached are the sight words (“popcorn words”) your child will learn in the second nine weeks. This list is a continuation of the words they were introduced to in the first nine weeks. Please practice these sight words with your child at home.

Here are some more suggestions on how to practice the sight words.

1. **Word-O** – This is played just like BINGO. Make a bingo card with the words that you would like to practice. Call out the words and mark the spaces. The first one to cover the card calls out “WORD-O!”
2. **Beat the clock** – How many sight words can you say in 1 minute.
3. Make words using **stencils**.
4. Make your own **dictionary/word wall** using scrapbook paper and the flashcards.
5. **Flashlight words** –Tape words on the wall or ceiling. Turn off the lights. Use a flashlight to shine on the word, then read it.
6. Write the words using **chalk** outside on the concrete.
7. **Word Hunt** – Look for sight words in magazines or in the newspaper. Highlight or circle the words you find.
8. **Paper Plate Toss** – Write the sight words on paper plates. Use like frisbees to throw after reading the word.
9. **Tic-Tac-Toe** – Write words in the tic-tac-toe spaces. Take turns selecting a space to read. If read correctly, an X or O is placed on the space until someone wins.
